Hello Dr. English, Dr. Saffary, Ms. Schweitzer,

Today was another interesting day for the junior class of the AUAF MBA program.

We were asked by Professor Asea to come to campus 30 minutes early (at 4:30 pm instead of 5 pm) and were then subjected to a PowerPoint presentation denouncing me personally and the program of reform I have asked the junior and senior classes to vote on anonymously. I have attached a draft of this proposal for your reference, and a photo of one slides from the PowerPoint. I asked Professor Asea for a copy of the PowerPoint (in case we might be tested on it later), but he denied my request.

As much as I enjoy sitting through an hour and a half of character assassination delivered via PowerPoint, as well as having my actual MBA classes cancelled because of 'upset students', I do feel compelled to lodge a formal complaint against Professor Patrick Asea. While this may be a radical position, I do not think that tonight's activities were an appropriate use of students' time or the USAID funds that subsidize this program.

I ask the AUAF administration and Board of Directors one final time - where is the line that a professor cannot cross in this graduate program? At what point will the leadership of AUAF intervene in this rapidly degenerating situation?
