

Memorandum to File

Under MBA Policies and Procedures, a MBA student may not fail a class or cannot earn more than two C's. However, under the policy, the student may re-take two courses to earn a higher grade in order to conform to academic standards.

David Fox (student ID18779) failed two classes. He re-took one of these classes but earned 'C'. He earned two additional C's and thus has a total of one failed class and three Cs. Although he had one more opportunity to re-take a class, it would not matter since this would not have allowed him to bring his academic record into standard. On the basis of this situation, he was expelled from the MBA program with no opportunity to re-apply.

Failed QMB 500 Decision Analysis Fall 2014

Retook QMB 500 Decision Analysis earning C Fall 2015

Failed QMB 501 Quantitative Business Methods Spring 2016

Earned C in FIN 550 Corporate Finance Summer 2016

Earned C+ MGT 500 Leading People and Organizations Fall 2016

In addition, David Fox entered the MBA program Summer 2014 and that means he would have to have finished by Spring 2017 to be awarded the degree. However, as of Fall 2016 he had earned only 33 credits which means that he would not have been able to complete all requirements by Spring 2017.
